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Conditional flashcards 2

TEACHER'S NOTES

This is a complementary resource for the genially 'Conditional Match'. There are 48 cards that you may use in the same way as suggested in the presentation or try some other games with your students.

Level: B2

Objective: To practice making conditional sentences:, all types.

Group practice 4-5 students

Put the cards face down and tell students to pick a card and finish the sentence. The Teacher or the next student decide if the sentence is correct. Ss can keep the correct cards. The ss with the most cards wins.

Conditional race

T divides the students into 2 groups and tells ss to raise their hand if they want to claim the card. Then T shows the first card and the race begins. The team with the most correctly finished sentences wins.

Pair activity

Ss sit facing each other and place a pile of cards between them face down. One s picks a card and starts a sentence that the other ss must finish.
