


TELLING TIME - TEACHER'S NOTES

This presentation gives the T a wide variety of activities to practice telling the time in a fun and interactive way. It can be used as a whole from the beginning to the end, but you can use it also as individual activities depending on the purpose. The activities teach ss not only the way to tell the time, but also to use it in a bigger context. The set contains the speaking activities as well as listening ones and encourages ss to practice telling the time in multiple situations.


* FIX IT

Ss look at the clock and the descriptions of different times. They move them around to the correct places. Click CHECK to see if they did everything correctly.

* SAY IT

T clicks  and changes the clocks while ss need to say the correct time.

* QUICK TIME

T shows a chart to quickly say the correct time. After around a minute the chart disappears and ss need to start over if they haven't finished. This button  resets the chart. If you want to practice without the timer, pick the **NO HURRY** version. You can also use the link from the INDEX page.

* MY DAY

Ss look at the chart and follow the activities, creating the correct sentences with time reference.

* MATCH IT

Learningapps matching game – match the descriptions with the clocks.

* LISTEN TO IT

Learningapps matching game – match the descriptions with the audio clocks.

* TIME MAZE

Ss listen to the audio with recorded hours and need to put the hours in order.

Use the activities as written exercises or pick any to suit your needs for the lesson.
