Lesson plan and notes:

This is a full lesson including the speaking, reading, vocabulary and listening activities for students of B2 and above. The order of activities is meant to smoothly introduce students to new vocabulary and practice both speaking and reading. However, when you go through the pages, T may decide to use individual elements that suit their needs.

Intro - brainstorming the topic and personal experiences connected with traveling to exotic places

Slide 3 - T starts by eliciting the knowledge on different traveling experiences discovering what ss already know about the subject.

Slide 4 - T shows different locations in South America and asks ss for their opinions. "Which location would you most like to visit and why?" and "Which dish would you like to try?" - T shows four different dishes.

What do you know?

Slide 5 - categorizing, the slide includes concepts connected with Columbia and the ones which are irrelevant. The aim of the activity is to predict which of them are correct and discuss the options.

Vocabulary practice

Slide 6 - contains two vocabulary activities which teach ss vocabulary recognition (quizlet - multiple choice exercise) and reinforce it (learningapps - match).

Reading practice

Slide 7 - contains the article and True and False questions. Tell ss to quickly scan the article for the correct answers and check together.

More reading practice

Slide 8 - contains open questions which require ss to read the article more closely and give more detailed answers.



Speaking - Did you know?

Slide 9 - Discussing fun facts about Columbia. This exercise aims to inform the students about interesting facts connected with Columbia as well as encourage them to express their own opinions. T should motivate the ss to say whether these ideas are new to them, or curious or surprising.

More vocabulary and text practice - gapped text

Slide 10 - gap filling exercise - the text about exploring **Video**

Slide 11 - there is a video included in the slide along with the text to fill in. Ss can do this exercise in the presentation or in a worksheet. The slide is not word sensitive so ss can write what they think is correct and later verify with the teacher. **video link**

More vocabulary practice - context sentences - quizlet link - words in context

Slide 12 - it includes a quizlet set with context sentences for ss to practice how many words they managed to remember after the lesson.
