

# EVERY DAY BREAKOUT ROOM - TEACHER'S NOTES

#### How to use the set

This is a gamified version of different vocabulary, reading and listening activities that revise Present Simple everyday vocabulary and reinforce language skills. The game includes 5 different activities that aim to check ss' knowledge of basic vocabulary and give them extra practice in context. The ss can't pass to the next challenge unless they complete the previous one. There are 5 challenges to complete after which the ss need to complete the task based on the information they collected. Tell ss to record or remember the clues on the way. The ss need to find out what Suzie does at the weekend which appears at the very end of the game.

This set can serve as a revision on the lesson or homework practice when ss can do the activities at their own pace.

## Challenge 1 - Find a match

It's a basic matching activity. SS need to properly match the words to the images. When they have done it, they click - **CHECK** - and collect the information needed to finish the whole activity. Then they pick another challenge.

# Challenge 2 - Write the activities

It's a spelling challenge that revises the vocabulary and teaches so correct spelling. When so have finished they click - **CHECK** - and collect the next piece of information.

# Challenge 3 - Complete the text

It's a gap fill where so need to complete the text using the words they have. It check's so' reading comprehension and teaches using the words in context. The so follow the same procedure as before.



# Challenge 4 - Listen and fill the notes

It's a listening comprehension exercise - a gap fill. Ss listen to the text and then write the missing information. It's the exercise that gives ss extra comprehension practice and shows them how the words they studied can be used in context. After completing the activity the procedure is the same.

# Challenge 5 - Sort out the information

It's another listening activity which improves ss' listening comprehension skills. SS need to listen to the descriptions of 3 people and sort out the information. After completing the activity ss follow the same procedure.
