

THE MYSTERY OF A MISSING PIE - BREAKOUT ROOM

Farm animals - learning vocabulary in context, reading a story

The activities are designed to progress from simple word recognition to more advanced context. All of them are put in a context of a simple story that students need to read. The activities allow students to practice vocabulary as well as more practical skills like reading and listening. You can also apply speaking or writing practice if you are monitoring ss work in class. Challenge 3 gives T a chance to ask ss to describe the placement of all the animals orally.

Intro

Part 4

You naughty mouse. Where's my apple pie? The mouse says, You always bake delicious cakes but I never eat them. So this time I ate it. I really love it. I'm really sorry.

Part 5

Mrs Hen is sorry that the mouse doesn't eat cakes with all the animals. So she decides to invite her to the kitchen for the next cake.
