

THE WEATHER TEACHER'S NOTES

level - A2

How to use the set

The aim of these activities is to introduce, learn or review the 'weather' vocabulary but also help students use all this vocabulary in practice. The activities aim at improving practical skills such as listening and speaking as well as reading. The set gives ss a lot of possibilities to learn the words connected with 'weather' but also see how they can be used in practice. T can choose between the activities to suit their needs for the lesson. The set can serve as a presentation of the vocabulary or organization of many fun reading or speaking activities. Instructions for students are in the titles of the activities

ACTIVITIES

LET'S LEARN - This is a simple flashcard set which can be used as a presentation of the vocabulary with accompanying sentences that show how these words work in context. T can use this set as an introduction or a revision depending on the needs.

LET'S LEARN MORE - There are 2 pages with cards that contain the weather words and the sentences on the flip side. Use the set to elicit what ss learnt from a previous set.

NAME MATCH / SPELL CHECK - These two activities practice name recognition and spelling of the words the ss studied. It's a fun way to play with and revise vocabulary.

LISTEN AND MATCH - This activity gives students a chance to understand spoken language and identify the words. The ss listen to full sentence which they must match to the correct image.



WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST - This activity is designed to help ss put the knowledge into practice. The ss get a the flashcards that demonstrate the weather for the whole week and need to talk about it. The lg to use includes the4 weather vocabulary as well as 'be going to' as the grammar. Because the cards are designed to pick the images at random, the possibilities for different weather types are unlimited. Click the icons at the bottom to choose each weather type. WEATHER FORECAST - This activity is designed to give ss a bit longer and more diverse speaking practice because the ss talk about the weather around the country. They should use the same structures as before but also include the world directions - east/west/north/south. The options are also picked at random which makes the exercise suitable for multiple use.

SEASONS OF THE YEAR - This is another speaking activity connected with weather vocabulary, however, this time, ss get to practice the common weather for each season of the year. The images of the seasons change, but the ss can see the weather symbols to help them talk about each season. T can use it as a writing prompt or simply as a speaking activity.

WEATHER REPORT 1, 2, 3 - These three slides include **Listening Comprehension** texts which ask ss to fill in the gaps. The ss hear weather reports and read the texts that need to be completed. The reports contain different vocabulary used in context to give ss extended vocabulary and skill practice.
