

MESSY HOUSE PLACEMENT - BREAKOUT TEACHER'S NOTES

level - A1+/A2

How to use the set

This is a breakout room is a fun set that revises **prepositions of placement** in context and improves ss' reading and listening comprehension. The set is aimed at young learners (8-11 years old). The set contains different activities that focus on listening or reading instructions that ss need to follow. The students need to complete 5 different challenges in order to open the reward and find the locations of the cat - Sir Biscuit.

ACTIVITIES

Challenge 1 - The living room - The ss listen to the instructions and move the objects to the correct places in order to clean up the room.

Challenge 2 - The kitchen - The ss need read the text and move the objects to the correct locations. When they have finished cleaning up, they can go to the next challenge.

Challenge 3 - Bedroom - This challenge checks spelling and understanding. It's a gap-fill exercise.

Challenge 4 - Bathroom - This is a mixed-skills exercise - reading and listening. The ss need to correctly understand the instructions in order to move the objects onto the correct places. After completing the task they can go to the next one.

Challenge 5 - The garden - This activity focuses on reading comprehension but only on selecting certain pieces of information. The ss need to pick/click the objects which are in the wrong places in the picture. When they make a mistake, they must repeat the exercise until they get the correct answer.

The Final task - when ss have completed the challenges, they get to the page with the final task where they fill in a simple text with the information about the location of the cat. There are images to help ss remember where he is.





Remember that the continue button appears only when the challenge is completed correctly.


The instructions are under the **CLEAN UP** sign which explain how to do the exercise.
