How to use the set

This is a breakout-room set that revises **animal names, body parts, can and can't, basic use of Present Simple**. The ss get through a series of reading and listening comprehension activities as well as many visual and vocabulary matching ones. The set helps ss to revise many animal names but also practice the use of these words in context. The set gives a lot of possibilities to read and speak using the assigned vocabulary and structures. **The instructions for the students are under the INFO button.**

Challenge 1: The Jungle

ACTIVITIES

Task 1 (Body parts in context): Sentences with gaps

Task 2 (Reading comprehension - gap fill): Gapped text with the words to put in. 4 descriptions of animals that live in the jungle - sloth, toucan, snake, jaguar - Ss answer the question - password - What animal doesn't live in the jungle? - penguin

Challenge 2: The Savannah

Task 1 (Can in context): Sentences to fill using can/can't

Task 2 (Listening comprehension): Gapped text - ss listen to the text and fill in the missing information

Task 3 (Description Match): Matching the images to the descriptions of the animals - meerkat, giraffe, hippo, elephant, zebra - Ss collect the code which opens the next clue - **58291**

Challenge 3: The Ocean/Sea

Task 1 (Gapped text): Words in context - Animals in the sea.

Task 2 (Reading comprehension questions): The questions to the text (previous task). SS answer the questions based on the information from the previous text. Ss collect the password which opens the next clue - WATER IS FUN

Challenge 4: The Bird House

Task 1 - (Matching) names on the image: Animal body parts

Task 2 - (Listening comprehension): Ss listen to the text and answer the questions. Lg focus - animal body parts and animal skills.

Task 3 - (Gapped text): Words in context. Ss read the text and fill it in with the words from the word bank. Ss collect the password that gets to the next clue - Password - Let's fly.

Challenge 5 - Mixed Habitat

Task 1 - (Description match) - Ss match the animals to the descriptions of the animals - turtle, monkey, sloth, toucan, butterfly, cheetah, frog

Task 2 - A Game - ss click the animals that they met in this habitat before. They collect the bananas and when the game is finished they answer the question to get the next clue - What is the smallest but the most colorful animal that lives there? - **BUTTERFLY**

The clues:

1. "I am taller than most animals in the forest or the savannah."
2. "I have a very long nose on my face that helps me eat and drink."
3. "I have big ears on my head that can move when I am hot."
4. "I eat a lot of green leaves and sometimes fruits from trees."
5. "I can make a very loud noise that sounds like a trumpet."

The Solution - **elephant**

Ss write in the solution and they need to complete the last challenge. The ss solve the code - **SOLUTION** - Small and tall, friends for all.

Challenge 2 - task 2 - listening practice

Cheetahs live on the savanna. They can **run** very fast. They hunt **small** animals for food. They can't **climb** trees.
 Zebras live in groups called herds. They can run and kick to protect themselves. They can't **fly** or **climb** trees.
 Meerkats live in burrows. They can **dig** quickly and **stand** on their back legs to look for danger. They can't **swim**.
 Elephants live on the grasslands. They can **walk** long distances and use their trunk to **drink** water. They can't fly or **jump**.

I am the Toucan - the Big Beak. I live in the tropical rainforest. I have a very large, colorful beak—it is orange and yellow. I make a loud croaking sound, like a frog. Listen to me!

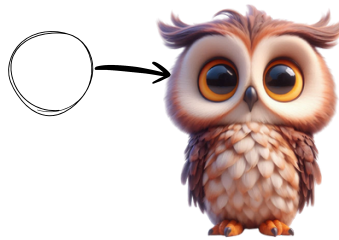
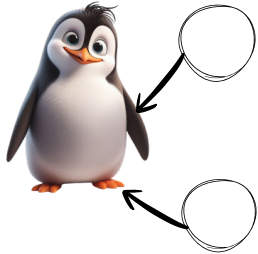

Riddle 2: I am small and green. I can jump very far and I live near water in the rainforest. Sometimes I make a loud “ribbit” sound. Who am I?

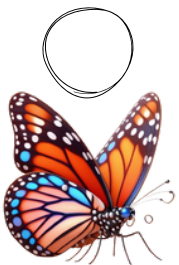
