How to use the set

Speaking Trios – B1–C2 is an interactive speaking game designed for older teens and adults. The set provides a wide range of topics that encourage students to express opinions, share experiences, analyse ideas, consider different perspectives and respond to hypothetical situations.

Students can decide which topic they want to talk about, giving them more choice and encouraging greater confidence and participation. Each level contains three categories with 30 different topics, giving 90 topics in total. Topics are selected at random, so the activity can be reused many times with different combinations.

The set works well for whole-class speaking, pair work, small groups, warm-ups, conversation classes, revision and exam speaking practice. The higher-level questions are also suitable for developing skills needed for Cambridge B2 First, C1 Advanced and C2 Proficiency speaking tasks.

How it works

The main board contains three speaking categories. The teacher or students can click individual envelopes to reveal one topic at a time, or use the SHOW button to reveal all three topics together.

There are two ways to play:

- Open speaking – students develop their answers for as long as they need.
- Timed speaking – students have a limited amount of time to respond.

For an additional speaking challenge, use the extension button:

- SPEAK MORE at B1/B2 – gives students an extra prompt to help them extend and develop their answer.
- CHALLENGE ME at C1 – adds a more demanding follow-up, asking students to defend, reconsider, qualify or expand their argument.

The extension can also be used in pairs: one student answers the main question and their partner reveals the follow-up challenge.

Use the RESTART button to reset the board and begin a new round.

Pick an envelope → reveal a topic → speak → develop your answer → take an extra challenge → restart for a new round.

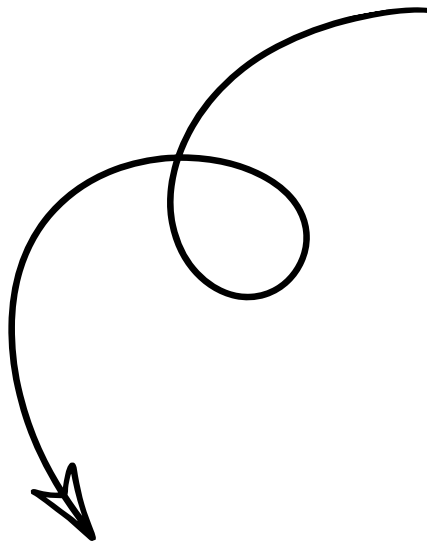


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
